WHITE WINES

Delicate & Light

W1. TOTI Blanc, Ch. Sept Chênes - Entre-Deux-Mers, Bordeaux, France **19**
A classic Bordeaux Sauvignon/Semillon blend with citrus and exotic fruit aromas and flavours.

W2. Pinot Grigio, Terrazze Della Luna - Trentino, Italy (V) **25**
A wine with real zest & vitality. Lemon scented, crisp and dry.

W3. Picpoul de Pinet, Cave de L’Ormarine, ‘Duc de Morny’ - Languedoc, France (V) **27**
Ripe melon on the nose, great balancing acidity and salinity – a perfect match to all seafood.

Aromatic

W4. Viognier, Emiliana, ‘Adobe Reserva’ - Colchagua Valley, Chile (V, O) **26**
Rich aromas of nectarine, white peach with honeysuckle & floral notes. Refreshing palate with good concentration and balance.

W5. Riesling QBA, Dr Loosen - Germany (V) **28**
Pineapple, honeydew melon, lemons & limes. A light, racy, medium-sweet Riesling.

W6. Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine du Pré Baron - Touraine, Loire, France (V) **30**
Intense & ripe, herbaceous & tropical, a very crisp mouth-watering wine.

W7. Assrytiko, Papagiannakos - PGI Attiki, Greece (V) **33**
Fresh floral aromas of citrus, white blossom, wild orange and lime with a textured, mineral palate and a refreshing saline acidity. A zesty, crisp and characterful wine perfect for shellfish & seafood.

W8. Albariño, Valmiñor, ‘Torroxal’ - Rias Baixas, Spain (V) **35**
Vibrant aromas of ripe peach and citrus fruit. The palate has apricot characters along with a touch of melon and fresh lime juice. This is a classic, crisp and refreshing Albariño with good length.

W9. Tahbilk Marsanne - Nagambie Lakes, Victoria, Australia **35**
Grapefruit zest and citrus floral aromas are carried through to a decidedly lively, mineral palate complemented by pear, Granny Smith apple and citrus fruits.

W10. Grüner Veltliner, Sepp Moser, ‘Von den Terrassen’ - Kremstal, Austria (O, B) **38**
Citrus and herbal aromas – with tropical spicy Veltliner notes and hints of green pepper. The palate has mineral and flinty characteristics, oriental spice and fresh citrus acidity on the finish.

W11. Sauvignon Blanc, Dog Point - Marlborough, New Zealand (V, O) **45**
Explosively pungent scents of passion fruit and grapefruit. This shows ample concentration, a silky mouthfeel and bright citrusy flavours.

W12. Sancerre ‘Silex’, Domaine Michel Girard - France (V) **50**
This is an outstanding wine with a lively and expressive palate full of minerality, complimented by a long finish.

W13. Riesling Grand Cru ‘Pfersigberg’, Bruno Sorg - Alsace, France (V, O) **58**
Exceptional, classic dry Riesling with a concentrated and rich palate of lime and wild flower fruit coupled with a silky texture. Easily a match for the very best Burgundy.

Rich & Full Bodied

W14. Rioja Blanco, López de Haro - Rioja, Spain (V) **28**
Classic oak aged white Rioja, with aromas of pears, greengages and herbs together with a hint of honeyed oak. A well-balanced and attractive dry, lightly rounded, yet fresh white wine.

W15. Verdicchio Classico, Monte Schiavo, ‘Pallio di San Floriano’ - Marche, Italy (V) **30**
Arguably the best producer in the Marche, an award winning rich and full flavoured wine with concentrated flavours of peach balanced by a crisp acidity and stony mineral notes.

W16. Chablis, Domaine Daniel Seguinot - Burgundy, France (V) **40**
Taut, crisp and linear Chablis, fresh flinty nose then vibrant, fleshy fruit.

W17. Chardonnay, Rustenberg - Stellenbosch, South Africa **40**
The palate is silky smooth with flavors of green apple and pear, followed by a refreshing acidity. Made from handpicked grapes and fermented in French oak barrels, this wine is full-bodied, elegant, and complex.

W18. Pouilly Fuisse, Eric Forest, ‘Les Crays’ - Burgundy, France (O, B) **65**
A powerfully flavoured wine, rich and beautifully structured with vanilla, spiced pear and toasty, marmalade notes.

W19. Chardonnay, Shaw & Smith, ‘M3’ - Adelaide Hills, Australia (V) **65**
A powerfully flavoured wine, rich and beautifully structured with vanilla, spiced pear and toasty, marmalade notes.

W20. Chablis Grand Cru, Nathalie & Gilles Fèvre, ‘Les Preuses’ - Burgundy, France (V, O) **95**
Highly elegant, expressive nose showing white flower and meadow aromas. Racy and intense fragrances on the palate with a substantial finish. Harmonious, subtle & complex.

RED WINES

Light to Medium Bodied & Fruity

- R1. TOTI Rouge, Bordeaux Supérieur, Ch. Roquecave** - Moullets et Villemartin, France **22**
Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc blend. Beautiful cherry red colour with cassis and liquorice aromas leading to dark fruit flavours.
- R2. Côtes-du-Rhône, ‘Les Coteaux’** - Rhône, France (V) **27**
Brambly fruit, sweet spice and a hint of smoke; classic Côtes-du-Rhône.
- R3. Kekfrankos, Schieber, ‘Trilogia’** - Szekszárd, Hungary (V) **28**
Deep ruby red colour, good structure and and medium body, this elegant wine has notes of cherries and spice, black pepper, with some oak notes in the background.
- R4. Fleurie, La Reine de L’Arenite, ‘La Madone’** - Beaujolais, France (V) **36**
Seductive perfumes of flowers and marzipan, full of fresh redcurrant fruit flavours.
- R5. Pinot Noir, Sileni Estates, ‘The Plateau’** - Hawkes Bay, New Zealand **38**
Complex aromas of dark berries leading to a rich palate of sweet dark cherry, spice & silky tannins.
- R6. Bougogne Pinot Noir, Vallet Frères** - Burgundy, France (V) **40**
Delicate garnet colour with peppery, strawberry fruit on the nose, the palate is light to medium-bodied with an appealing acidity balancing the dry tannins and elegant red fruit.
- R7. Nuits-St-Georges 1er Cru ‘Les Perrieres’, Pascal Marchand** - Burgundy, France **90**
Juicy red fruit, delicate floral aromas, soft spices and fresh minerals are carefully wrapped in ripe tannins, offering both complexity and fine balance. Elegant and very refined.

Medium Bodied with More Depth

- R8. Monastrell, Juan Gil Family Estates, ‘Pedrera’** - Jumilla, Spain (V) **24**
Ripe, juicy bramble & plum flavours, just a hint of fresh spice & a supple juicy finish.
- R9. Aliança Dão** - DOC Dão, Portugal (V) **25**
Ripe and full-flavoured with supple tannins and notes of blackberry and wild plum, which follow through to a long and juicy finish.
- R10. Malbec, Pablo Y Walter** - Mendoza, Argentina (V) **30**
A really pure expression of Malbec. Bright red & juicy, rich chocolate flavours
- R11. Agiorgitiko, Gaia** - Nemea, Greece (V) **35**
Classy, silky smooth wine packed with soft red fruit and black cherries produced by one of the pioneers of modern Greek wine.
- R12. Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Ontanon** - Rioja Oriental, Spain **44**
Bramble fruit & spice with fine tannins; elegant and lengthy finish.

- R13. Valpolicella Ripasso, Corte Giara** - Veneto, Italy (V) **40**
Plump red fruit combines with sweet spices and herbs to provide a wine with excellent structure and vibrant acidity. Made by leading Veronese winemakers Allegrini.
- R14. Clos de la Cure, St-Émilion Grand Cru** - Bordeaux, France (V) **50**
A wine with real elegance and finesse; plush and full bodied with rich flavours of blackcurrant, dark cherry and chocolate.
- R15. Aalto** - Ribera del Duero, Spain (V) **70**
Highly complex with intense aromas of black cherry, raspberry, wood spice and coffee beans. On the palate this wine is fresh, long, and meaty with sweet and elegant tannins. Velvety and silky smooth.

Full Bodied and Rich

- R16. Domaine de Tourelles** - Bekaa Valley, Lebanon (V) **30**
Deep colour with expressive aromas of cherries, cedar, rosemary & cloves leading to a palate of Morello cherry, blackberry & spice. A wine packed with flavour & heritage.
- R17. Primitivo di Manduria, San Marzano, ‘Talo’** - Puglia, Italy (V) **35**
A rich and opulent wine with vibrant flavours of ripe cherries and plums combined with subtle overtones of cocoa and vanilla. Velvety and textured with a warm finish.
- R18. Shiraz, Mitolo, ‘The Jester’** - McLaren Vale, Australia (V) **38**
Aromas of ripe dark fruits, black olives and oak char. A full-bodied, mouth-filling wine with fine grained tannins and concentrated dark fruits.
- R19. ‘Le Volte’, Tenuta dell’Ornellaia** - Tuscany, Italy (V, O) **55**
Smooth, intense and velvety, with a rich and fruity flavour dominated by blackberry, plum, and tobacco. The wine is well-structured with a firm tannic backbone.
- R20. Cabernet Sauvignon, Vasse Felix** - Margaret River, Australia (V, O) **65**
Wonderfully fragrant and luscious, with notes of cassis, plum, cedar, cigar box and bay leaf on the nose. The palate is full but fine, with complex and luxurious black-fruit and spice flavours.
- R21. Ch Cantemerle 5ème Cru** - Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux, France **80**
Well balanced, plush Haut-Medoc with fresh redcurrant and darker cherry notes. Good acidity ensures a long fresh finish with fine grained tannins.

SPARKLING WINES

- S1. Crémant d’Alsace, Cave de Turckheim, ‘Mayerling Brut’** - Alsace, France (V) **38**
An excellent quality crémant, made in the same way as Champagne.
- S2. Brut, Stephane Breton** - Champagne, France **55**
A small grower Champagne; Breton produces a deliciously fresh, buttery Champagne with a soft creamy mousse.
- S3. Hattingley Valley Classic Reserve N.V.** - Hampshire, England (V) **65**
Pale gold in colour with delicate and fine long-lasting bubbles. Aromas of green apples, brioche and delicate toasted notes. On the palate the complexity continues with notes of soft lemon sherbet, biscuit and a subtle oak character. Refreshing and perfectly balanced
- S4. Rosé, Stephane Breton** - Champagne, France **60**
Beautiful bright pink, delicate aromas of small red fruits with a long and complex finish.
- S5. Blanc de Blancs NV, Champagne Henriot** - Reims, France (V) **78**
The nose expresses freshness with delicate citrus and peach notes. The freshness continues on the palate and melts into notes of buttery brioche. Beautiful length and wonderfully rounded in the mouth.
- S6. La Cuvee NV, Laurent Perrier** - Tours-sur-Marne, France (V) **90**
A perfect balance between freshness and finesse, La Cuvee is full-bodied, complex and creamy, displaying great length on the finish.
- S7. Billecart-Salmon Brut Rosé** - Mareuil-sur-Ay, France (V) **100**
Pale and radiant pink with fine notes of red fruits, elegant and fine.
- S8. Louis Roederer Vintage** - Reims, France (V, O) **125**
Intense Pinot Noir nose, fleshy and vinous texture with a lovely acidity. Mouth watering flavours leave a final sensation of lightness, generosity and elegance.

ROSÉ WINES

- R01. Gris de Gris, Dune** - Languedoc, France (V) **25**
Pale salmon in colour, crisp and refreshing with aromas of pink grapefruit and white peach. Ideal as an apéritif, or with light meat dishes, fish and seafood.
- R02. Rosé d’Anjou, Pierre Chainier, ‘Selection 1749’** - Loire, France (V) **25**
Pale strawberry pink in colour, delicate summer pudding aromas and a round medium-dry palate with balancing and refreshing acidity.
- R03. Domaine de la Vieille Tour Rosé** - Côtes de Provence, France (O) **32**
A classic blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault this is a perfect pale raspberry pink that screams Provence. Delicate aromas, clean and well balanced with some depth
- R04. Whispering Angel, Ch. D’Esclans** - Côtes de Provence, France **50**
Pale salmon in colour, this delicate Provençal pink has a full and complex taste profile. The palate offers flavours of peach and raspberries with refreshing citrus undertones and a smooth, dry finish.

DESSERT WINES

- D1. Monbazillac, Dom. de Grange Neuve** - Périgord, France (V) (500ml) **25**
Sweet and luscious with a great backbone of fine acidity for a clean finish. Flavours on the palate are rich; honey with a finishing twist of bitter orange.
- D2. Late Harvest Mourvèdre, Cline Cellars** - California, USA (V) (375ml) **30**
This wine is luxuriously sweet and divinely tempting. Layers of coffee, After-Eight chocolates, black berries and prunes dominate but they are beautifully balanced with a firm structure of acid and fine grained tannins.
- D3. Black Muscat, Quady, ‘Elysium’** - California, USA (V) (375ml) **30**
Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit.
